FACILITIES: Come dressed to run. Porta-johns located across the street from the parking lot, but no showers.

AID STATION: One well-stocked aid station per loop, providing water, sports drinks, and a wide assortment of food stuffs. Please bring your special nutrition needs, to be staged at the pavilion, as needed.

From Baltimore: (Travel time approx. 45 mins.) Take Route 97-South to Route 50-East. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for US-50 E/US-301 N/Annapolis/Bay Bridge. Keep right at the fork and merge onto MD-665 E. Continue onto Forest Dr and turn right at Hillsmere Dr. The park entrance is on the right. Continue in and turn right into the White Oak Pavillion parking lot. *Carpool recommended.*

From the Washington Beltway I-495/95: (Travel time approx. 1/2 hour.) Take exit #19-A onto Route 50-East. Take the exit toward MD-665 E. Continue onto Forest Dr and turn right at Hillsmere Dr. The park entrance is on the right. Continue in and turn right into the White Oak Pavillion parking lot. *Carpool recommended.*
